Kajumulo teams will consider providing a limited number of need-based scholarships based on total household income, using the same income guidelines as the national Reduced-Price Lunch Program. These scholarships may be available to help defray a portion of the team fees. They do not cover all costs, e.g., uniform costs are not included. The equivalent of one scholarship may be available to cover costs associated with one player or, if more than one application is received, cover an allocated portion of costs. Team fundraising activities may be considered if insufficient scholarship funds are available.
